### **Our Mission**

To provide immediate financial assistance to families of public safety officers and firefighters who are seriously injured or killed in the line of duty, and to provide resources to enhance their safety and welfare.

### **Our Benefits and Programs**

- Line of duty death benefit of \$15,000.
  - Non line of duty death benefit of \$5,000.
  - Up to \$18,000 for serious line-of-duty injury (initial benefit requires 30 consecutive days off duty)
  - The Safety Enhancement Stipend program (SES), awards money to public safety agencies to purchase equipment, training and programs that directly enhance the safety of their officers or firefighters. Applications are reviewed quarterly and awards determined by need, demand and availability of funds.
  - The 100 Club Scholarship Program provides financial assistance for family members of public safety officers and firefighters that wish to continue their education beyond high school.
  - The Professional Advisory Team (PAT) is a group of dedicated professionals, assembled to assist the public safety families who experience a life altering event and is provided to requesting families without charge or obligation.

### **Our Statistics**

- The 100 Club has provided more than 4 million dollars to over 850 public safety families since its inception in 1968.
  - More than \$530,000 in Safety Enhancement Stipends has been awarded to public safety agencies across Arizona.
  - Membership consists of more than 2,500 people, businesses and organizations from across the state.
