2024 was a year of sacrifice for Arizona's police officers and firefighters. We lost 24 brave individuals from our public safety community across the state. It was an honor to support each of their families during this difficult time.

While our organization was originally established to support Line of Duty Deaths, our mission has grown over the years. In 2024 alone, we provided \$3.8 million in support for those injured in the line of duty, public safety families facing unexpected and life-altering events, scholarships for immediate family members, safety enhancement stipends, mental health services, and more. Since our inception, we've delivered more than \$27 million in assistance to public safety members and agencies across Arizona.

As our public safety family faces new challenges, we remain committed to expanding our programs, training, and overall support. We are proud to stand with our officers and firefighters on the front lines, and we thank you for your continued support in making this work possible.

\$20,000 one-time assistance

\$10,000 one-time assistance

\$500-\$1,500 per month based on injury

HEROES:

Up to \$7,500 one-time assistance for lifealtering events (loss of spouse or child, terminal illness)
